## A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation from the general fund of the  
2 state to the Iowa American revolution bicentennial  
3 commission.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. The members of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly,  
2 having been elected to serve during the observance of America's  
3 bicentennial, recognize the importance of many of the ideas  
4 associated with the American revolution in the development  
5 of Iowa. An awareness of this heritage and of the  
6 opportunities that lie ahead is essential to maintaining and  
7 improving the quality of life that Iowans have enjoyed and  
8 deserve. It is the intent of this General Assembly that the  
9 funds appropriated by this Act be used to encourage maximum  
10 participation by Iowans in activities commemorating the  
11 historic events of the American revolutionary period and  
12 the heritage of this state, and in projects developing new  
13 directions and opportunities for Iowa's future.

14 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of  
15 the state to the Iowa American revolution bicentennial  
16 commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and  
17 ending June 30, 1976, the sum of two hundred thousand (200,000)  
18 dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary to be used for  
19 bicentennial projects endorsed by the Iowa American revolution  
20 bicentennial commission. Funds appropriated by this Act shall  
21 be allocated by the commission to bicentennial projects only  
22 if matched by an equal amount of money raised by the sponsors  
23 of the bicentennial project from other sources.

24 Sec. 3. All federal and private grants to and the receipts  
25 of the Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission are  
26 appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants  
27 or receipts.

28 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
29 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
30 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
31 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30,  
32 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976.  
33 In all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
34 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.

This bill appropriates two hundred thousand dollars to the Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976, to be used for bicentennial programs approved by the commission. The commission is authorized to allocate the money only if the state money is matched by an equal amount of funds raised from other sources.

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE  
TO THE IOWA AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The members of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, having been elected to serve during the observance of America's bicentennial, recognize the importance of many of the ideas associated with the American revolution in the development of Iowa. An awareness of this heritage and of the opportunities that lie ahead is essential to maintaining and improving the quality of life that Iowans have enjoyed and deserve. It is the intent of this General Assembly that the funds appropriated by this Act be used to encourage maximum participation by Iowans in activities commemorating the historic events of the American revolutionary period and the heritage of this state, and in projects developing new directions and opportunities for Iowa's future.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976, the sum of two hundred thousand (200,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary to be used for bicentennial projects endorsed by the Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission. Funds appropriated by this Act shall be allocated by the commission to bicentennial projects only if matched by an equal amount of money raised by the sponsors of the bicentennial project from other sources.

Sec. 3. All federal and private grants to and the receipts of the Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976. In all other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.
