1 An Act creating and making an appropriation to the executive
2 council general contingent fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend Senate File 561, as passed by the Senate,
2 as follows:
3 Page 1, by inserting after line 28 the follow-
4 ing new section:
5 "Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the general
6 fund of the state to the executive council for the
7 fiscal year commencing July 1, 1975 and ending June
8 30, 1976 the following amounts or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary to be used for the following
10 purpose:

tion.....\$5,000,000"

1 Section 1. There is created an executive council general
2 contingent fund. The fund shall be administered by the ex-
3 ecutive council. Allocations from the fund may be made only
4 for contingencies arising during the fiscal year commencing
5 July 1, 1975 which are legally payable from the funds of the
6 state. The executive council shall not approve allocation
7 of any funds for any purpose or project which was presented
8 to the general assembly by way of a bill and which failed
9 to become enacted into law, nor shall the executive council
10 approve allocations from the fund for any purpose which is
11 not a contingency according to law or is not a contingency
12 for which funds may be allocated according to law.

13 Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall
14 be allocated, a written recommendation shall first be obtained
15 from the state comptroller and the executive council shall
16 determine that the proposed allocation shall be for the best
17 interest of the state. The executive council shall not spend
18 any money out of the contingent fund while the general assembly

20 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of

22 for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1975 and ending June
23 30, 1976, the following amount, or so much thereof as may
24 be necessary, to be used in the manner provided in section
25 one (1) of this Act.

EXPLANATION

This bill appropriates \$50,000 for the executive council
contingency fund. A contingency does not include any purpose
or project presented to the general assembly which failed
to become law. If a purpose is specified by law, it is not
a contingency.

AN ACT

CREATING AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL GENERAL CONTINGENT FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is created an executive council general contingent fund. The fund shall be administered by the executive council. Allocations from the fund may be made only for contingencies arising during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1975 which are legally payable from the funds of the state. The executive council shall not approve allocation of any funds for any purpose or project which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted into law, nor shall the executive council approve allocations from the fund for any purpose which is not a contingency according to law or is not a contingency for which funds may be allocated according to law.

Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall be allocated, a written recommendation shall first be obtained from the state comptroller and the executive council shall determine that the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the state. The executive council shall not spend any money out of the contingent fund while the general assembly is in session.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the executive council general contingent fund for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976, the following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the manner provided in section one (1) of this Act.
