1 Section 1. Section two hundred sixty-nine point two  
2 (269.2), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 269.2 EXPENSES--RESIDENCE OF INDIGENTS. The provisions  
4 of sections 270.4 to 270.87-~~inclusive~~, and section two (2)  
5 of this Act are hereby made applicable to the Iowa braille  
6 and sight-saving school.

7 Sec. 2. Chapter two hundred seventy (270), Code 1975,  
8 is amended by adding the following new section:

9 NEW SECTION. There is appropriated from the general fund  
10 of the state to the state board of regents an amount necessary  
11 to be distributed to the institution for payments to the  
12 parents or guardians of pupils in the institution as follows:

13 1. Transportation reimbursement at the rate specified  
14 in section two hundred eighty-five point one (285.1), subsec-  
15 tion three (3), of the Code to the parents or guardians of  
16 children who do not reside in the institution, but are trans-  
17 ported to the institution on a daily basis.

18 2. Transportation reimbursement at the rate specified  
19 in section two hundred eighty-five point one (285.1),  
20 subsection three (3), of the Code to the parents or guardians  
21 for not more than ten trips per year from the institution  
22 to the residence of the parent or guardian and return to the  
23 institution for children who reside in the institution.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill provides reimbursement to the parents and  
26 guardians of pupils in the school for the deaf and the Iowa  
27 braille and sight-saving school for transportation costs to  
28 and from the schools both for pupils who reside in the schools  
29 and those who reside at home.
