1 Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975  
2 Session, chapter fifty-eight (58), section two (2), is amended  
3 by adding the following subsection:

4 9. Funds appropriated by paragraphs a of subsections two  
5 (2), three (3), five (5), and eight (8) of this section include  
6 the state's contribution to the peace officers' retirement,  
7 accident, and disability system provided in chapter ninety-

10 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,

15 EXPLANATION

16 The appropriation Act of 1975 did not specify the funding  
17 level for the peace officers' retirement system. This bill  
18 corrects that oversight.

AN ACT  
RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC  
SAFETY MADE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter fifty-eight (58), section two (2), is amended by adding the following subsection:

9. Funds appropriated by paragraphs a of subsections two (2), three (3), five (5), and eight (8) of this section include the state's contribution to the peace officers' retirement, accident, and disability system provided in chapter ninety-seven A (97A) of the Code in the amount of sixteen percent of the salaries for which the funds are appropriated.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Cherokee Daily Times, a newspaper published in Cherokee, Iowa, and in The Winterset Madisonian, a newspaper published in Winterset, Iowa.
