Prepared in regard to Senate File 1177, An Act relating to special
registration plates for revoked license.

Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative
proposal as required by Joint Rule 16.

This bill provides a means for readily identifying vehicles
belonging to persons whose drivers licenses have been mandatorily
revoked.

The estimated cost of providing readily identifiable license
plates is approximately \$14,000 per year. This estimate would
include one additional clerk typist II (starting \$5400) to pro-
cess and mail the special plates and account for & return the
original plates after reinstatement of the owner's drivers license.

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
2 hundred nine (321.209), Code 1975, is amended by adding the
3 following new paragraph:

4 NEW PARAGRAPH. Upon conviction of a person for any of
5 the above offenses, the department may exercise its authority
6 under section three hundred twenty-one point fourteen (321.14)
7 of the Code, and take possession of the registration plates
8 and registration certificates of any motor vehicles registered
9 in the person's name or owned by such person. The department
10 shall retain custody of the surrendered plates and certificates
11 until the driver's license of the person has been reinstated.
12 Upon application to the department, accompanied by a fee of
13 three dollars, the department shall issue new registration
14 plates to the person. The new registration plates shall bear
15 a special series number so as to render them readily
16 identifiable to traffic law enforcement officers. The new
17 registration plates bearing a special series number shall
18 be surrendered to the department at the time the driver's
19 license of such person is reinstated.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides a means for readily identifying vehicles
22 belonging to persons whose drivers licenses have been
23 mandatorily revoked. The vehicles may be checked to determine
24 if the driver is driving in violation of the revocation.
25 It provides for the impoundment of the registration plates
26 of such a person and the issuance of new plates with a special
27 series number to make identification easier.
