1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the state board of regents for the fiscal
3 year beginning July 1, 1976 the sum of five hundred thousand
4 (500,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to
5 be used for capital improvements, replacements or alterations
6 deemed necessary by the board of regents for the purpose of
7 removing or altering those features of buildings at the state
8 universities which prevent or unduly impede access of
9 orthopedically handicapped persons to those buildings.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill appropriates \$500,000 to the Board of Regents
12 for capital projects specifically designed to remove
13 architectural barriers which make it difficult for physically
14 handicapped persons to use buildings at the state universities.
15 The amount appropriated will not permit all such work which
16 is needed at the three universities to be accomplished, but
17 will make it possible to begin this effort.
