1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point three  
2 hundred eighty-one (321.381), Code 1975, is amended to read  
3 as follows:

4 321.381 SCOPE AND EFFECT OF REGULATIONS. It is a mis-  
5 demeanor, punishable as provided in section 321.482, for any  
6 person to drive or move or for the owner to cause or knowingly  
7 permit to be driven or moved on any highway any vehicle or  
8 combination of vehicles which is in such unsafe condition  
9 as to endanger any person, or which does not contain those  
10 parts or is not at all times equipped with such lamps and  
11 other equipment in proper condition and adjustment as required  
12 in this chapter, or which is equipped with one or more unsafe  
13 tires or which is equipped in any manner in violation of this  
14 chapter. However, a warning ticket shall be issued for the  
15 first violation for failing to have lights in operational  
16 order. The owner shall have fourteen days from the issuance  
17 of the warning ticket to repair the defective lights for which  
18 the warning ticket is issued.

19 Sec. 2. Section seven hundred fifty-three point fifteen  
20 (753.15), subsection three (3), Code 1975, is amended to read  
21 as follows:

22 3. Improper lights, for the second and subsequent  
23 violations, ten dollars.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill provides for the issuance of a warning ticket  
26 for failing to have light equipment operational. This warning  
27 is in lieu of the current \$10 fine.
