1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred thirty-two (332), Code
2 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. Sheriffs and deputies shall not use pri-
4 vate automobiles in the performance of their duties of of-
5 fice unless such use is pursuant to a contract made between
6 the board of supervisors and the sheriff or deputy, as the
7 case may be, as set forth in subsection eighteen (18) of
8 section three hundred thirty-two point three (332.3) of the
9 Code. If no such contract is made regarding use of private
10 vehicles, the board of supervisors must provide as many county-
11 owned automobiles as the board determines are needed for the
12 sheriff and deputies to perform their duties of office.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that the county must either provide
15 automobiles for the sheriff and deputies to perform their
16 duties of office or it must contract with the sheriff and/or
17 deputies for them to use private automobiles to perform their
18 duties of office.

AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLES USED BY SHERIFFS AND DEPUTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter three hundred thirty-two (332), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. Sheriffs and deputies shall not use private automobiles in the performance of their duties of office unless such use is pursuant to a contract made between the board of supervisors and the sheriff or deputy, as the case may be, as set forth in subsection eighteen (18) of section three hundred thirty-two point three (332.3) of the Code. If no such contract is made regarding use of private vehicles, the board of supervisors must provide as many county-owned automobiles as the board determines are needed for the sheriff and deputies to perform their duties of office.
