A BILL FOR

1 An Act appropriating and allocating funds to the state
2 board of regents to supplement funds appropriated for
3 the 1975-1976 fiscal year.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the state board of regents the sum of one
3 million five hundred thousand (1,500,000) dollars, or so much
4 thereof as is necessary, for the purpose of supplementing
5 funds available to the state board of regents during the
6 fiscal period commencing July 1, 1975. The state board of
7 regents shall allocate moneys from funds appropriated by this
8 section to institutions under its control to replace losses
9 of anticipated revenue resulting because federal educational
10 and capitation grants do not become available. Moneys shall
11 not be allocated under this section unless such allocation
12 is first approved by the governor and the state comptroller.
13 It is not the intent of this section to supplement federal
14 funds relating solely to sponsored research grants to in-
15 stitutions under the jurisdiction of the board of regents.

16 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Acts of
17 the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter sixty
18 (60), section seven (7), the state board of regents may ex-
19 pend for the benefit of institutions under its control any
20 funds appropriated to the state board of regents by such act
21 if such funds were budgeted for fuel and electricity during
22 the 1975-1976 fiscal year and it is determined by the state
23 board of regents that such funds will not be needed for such
24 purposes. The funds shall be expended for operating purposes.

25 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
26 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
27 tion in the Grinnell Herald-Register, a newspaper published
28 in Grinnell, Iowa, and in The Independent, a newspaper
29 published in Hawarden, Iowa.

30 EXPLANATION

31 The \$1,500,000 appropriated by section 1 of this Act is
32 intended to supplement the existing appropriation made to
33 the state comptroller in the amount of \$900,000. The state
34 board of regents will have \$1,500,000 plus the share received
35 from the state comptroller to solve problems resulting from

1 federal fund losses.

2 Section 2 provides an incentive for fuel cost savings and
3 could provide funds to be used for special problems.

AN ACT
APPROPRIATING AND ALLOCATING FUNDS TO THE STATE BOARD OF
REGENTS TO SUPPLEMENT FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR THE 1975-1976
FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the state board of regents the sum of one million five hundred thousand (1,500,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the purpose of supplementing funds available to the state board of regents during the fiscal period commencing July 1, 1975. The state board of regents shall allocate moneys from funds appropriated by this section to institutions under its control to replace losses of anticipated revenue resulting because federal educational and capitation grants do not become available. Moneys shall not be allocated under this section unless such allocation is first approved by the governor and the state comptroller. It is not the intent of this section to supplement federal funds relating solely to sponsored research grants to institutions under the jurisdiction of the board of regents.

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter sixty (60), section seven (7), the state board of regents may expend for the benefit of institutions under its control any funds appropriated to the state board of regents by such act if such funds were budgeted for fuel and electricity during the 1975-1976 fiscal year and it is determined by the state board of regents that such funds will not be needed for such purposes. The funds shall be expended for operating purposes.

Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-

tion in the Grinnell Herald Register, a newspaper published in Grinnell, Iowa, and in The Independent, a newspaper published in Hawarden, Iowa.
