A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the partial unemployment under employment
2 security.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section ninety-six point nineteen (96.19),
2 subsection ten (10), Code 1975, as amended by the Acts of
3 the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1975 Session, chapter ninety-
4 two (92), sections thirty-one (31), thirty-two (32), and
5 thirty-three (33), is amended by striking the subsection,
6 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 10. "TOTAL, PARTIAL, AND TEMPORARY UNEMPLOYMENT".

8 a. An individual shall be deemed "totally unemployed"
9 in any week with respect to which no wages are payable to
10 the individual and during which he performs no services.

11 b. An individual shall be deemed partially unemployed
12 in any week in which, while employed at a regular job, the
13 individual works less than the regular full-time week and
14 in which the individual earns less than the individual weekly
15 benefit amount plus fifteen dollars.

16 c. An individual shall be deemed partially unemployed
17 in any week in which he or she, having been separated from
18 the individual's regular job, earns at odd jobs less than
19 his or her weekly benefit amount plus fifteen dollars.

20 d. An individual shall be deemed temporarily unemployed
21 if for a period, verified by the commission, not to exceed
22 four consecutive weeks, he or she is unemployed due to a plant
23 shutdown, vacation, inventory, lack of work or emergency from
24 the regular job or trade in which he or she worked full time
25 and in which he or she will again work full time, if his or
26 her employment, although temporarily suspended, has not been
27 terminated.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill specifically provides benefits for partial
30 unemployment where the individual works less than the regular
31 full-time week at his or her regular job. The bill also
32 reinserts the definition for "temporarily unemployed".
