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EXPLANATION

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This bill appropriates funds to the state board of regents for allocation to the three state universities as reimbursement for tuition, fees, charges and institutional income that was used to finance the cost of providing buildings and facilities and utility services at such institutions. Funds are also appropriated for projects in a lump sum appropriation intended to give the state board of regents flexibility in the completion of the capital projects.

The bill also provides for the purchase of one video tape recorder by the education radio and television facility board, authorizes specific purchase of radio equipment to extend a statewide radio network, and to further study the completion of a statewide radio network. The bill also provides that funds appropriated in 1974 to the department of general services for use of the educational radio and television facility board for the installation of translators to provide educational television coverage throughout the state revert in 1980.

The bill also appropriated funds to the department of public instruction to be dispersed to western Iowa technical community college for radio broadcasting facilities subject to receipt of a matching federal grant.

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO VARIOUS STATE EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES TO PROVIDE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF STATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS FOR DEFICIENCIES IN OPERATING FUNDS CAUSED BY FUNDS PLEDGED TO FINANCE ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES AND UTILITY SERVICES, FOR PURCHASING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REVERSION OF FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1976, to the following state agencies the following amounts or so much thereof as is necessary to be used for the purposes designated:

1. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS

a. For allocation by the state board of regents to the state university of Iowa, the Iowa state university of science and technology, and the university of northern Iowa in such amounts as may be necessary to reimburse such institutions for deficiencies in their operating funds resulting from the pledging of tuitions, student fees and charges and institutional income to finance the cost of providing academic and administrative buildings and facilities and utility services at such institutions..... \$ 3,300,000

b. For capital improvement items for construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements, purchase of land, leases, equipment, replacements or alterations, or for any other capital expenditures the state board of regents may deem necessary for the proper and necessary functions of all institutions under its jurisdiction..... \$10,300,000

c. For the purpose of initiating a capital improvement program to make state facilities under the jurisdiction of the board accessible to the physically handicapped..... \$ 500,000

d. For detailed architectural plans for the Lindquist Center, phase II, at the state university of Iowa, for Quadrangle remodeling, phase I, at Iowa state university of science and technology, and for a music building, at Iowa state university of science and technology..... \$ 600,000

2. EDUCATIONAL RADIO AND TELEVISION FACILITY BOARD

a. For the purchase of one video tape recorder..... \$ 103,000

b. For engineering studies to determine the possible location, design characteristics, and cost of establishing educational radio stations in those parts of the state not served by existing educational radio stations; and to determine what types of interconnection systems could be made between any new stations and the existing stations to possibly

reduce the programming demands on any one station and to identify the costs of such interconnect systems..... \$ 30,000

3. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

For dispersement to western Iowa technical community college for educational broadcasting facilities subject to receipt of a matching one hundred eighty thousand dollar grant from the United States department of health, education, and welfare..... \$ 60,000

Sec. 2.

1. Unobligated or unencumbered funds remaining on June 30, 1977, from funds appropriated by paragraph a of subsection one (1) of section one (1) of this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state on September 30, 1977.

2. Unobligated or unencumbered funds remaining on June 30, 1980 from funds appropriated by the following provisions of this Act shall revert to the general fund on September 30, 1980.

- a. Paragraph b of subsection one (1) of section one (1).
b. Paragraph c of subsection one (1) of section one (1).
c. Paragraph d of subsection one (1) of section one (1).
d. Subsection two (2) of section one (1).
e. Subsection three (3) of section one (1).

Sec. 3. Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1974 Session, chapter one thousand thirty-one (1031), section four (4), is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 4. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of general services for the use of the educational radio and television facility board, the sum of five hundred thousand (500,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the installation of translators to aid in providing educational television coverage throughout the state. The educational radio and television facility

board shall determine the manner that the funds appropriated by this section shall be expended; however, a translator shall not be purchased or installed until a transmitter is in complete operation and there is a definite need for a translator to supplement that transmitter. Unencumbered funds by this section shall revert to the general fund of the state on August 31, 1976 1980.

Sec. 4. The department of public instruction, the educational radio and television facility board, the state board of regents, the governor, and the state comptroller may obtain federal grants for the state to be used in connection with the funds appropriated by this Act.
