1 Section 1. Section two hundred four point two hundred
2 four (204.204), subsection four (4), Code 1975, is amended
3 by adding the following new paragraphs:

4 NEW PARAGRAPH. Thio phencyclidine (1-(1-(2-
5 thienyl)cyclohexyl) piperidine).

6 NEW PARAGRAPH. 2,5 - dimethoxyamphetamine.

7 NEW PARAGRAPH. 4 - Bromo - 2,5 dimethoxyamphetamine.

8 NEW PARAGRAPH. 4 - methoxyamphetamine.

AN ACT

TO DEFINE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL SUBSTANCES AS CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred four point two hundred four (204.204), subsection four (4), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

NEW PARAGRAPH. Thio phencyclidine (1-(1-(2-thienyl)cyclohexyl) piperidine).

NEW PARAGRAPH. 2,5 - dimethoxyamphetamine.

NEW PARAGRAPH. 4 - Bromo - 2,5 dimethoxyamphetamine.

NEW PARAGRAPH. 4 - methoxyamphetamine.

Sec. 2. Section two hundred four point two hundred six (204.206), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new subsections:

NEW SUBSECTION. Cocaine.
