SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution to continue the governor's task force on
2 early childhood development and making an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. The governor's task force on early childhood
2 development, established under the provisions of Senate Con-
3 current Resolution one hundred twenty-five (125), adopted
4 by the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1974 Session, is continued
5 until January 16, 1976 in order to continue its study of
6 methods of planning and coordinating services to young children
7 and to assess and evaluate the need in Iowa for an office
8 for early childhood development. The task force shall make
9 its final report and recommendations to the governor and to
10 the Sixty-sixth General Assembly not later than January 16,
11 1976, including proposed legislation as necessary to implement
12 its recommendations.

13 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of
14 the state to the office of the governor for the fiscal year
15 commencing July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 the sum of
16 fifty thousand (50,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary, to provide funds for staff assistance and other
18 assistance, including an office, as determined by the task
19 force.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This Joint Resolution, which carries an enacting clause,
22 and if enacted will be law, notes the appointment of a gov-
23 ernor's task force in 1974 and the presentation of a report
24 of such task force. The continuation of the task force is
25 recommended and an appropriation is provided for \$50,000.
26 The task force is to continue its study of methods of plan-
27 ning and coordinating services to young children and evalua-
28 tion of the need in Iowa for an office for early childhood.
29 A final report of the task force must be made to the Sixty-
30 sixth General Assembly not later than January 16, 1976.
