1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one  
2 hundred fifty-two (321.152), Code 1977, is amended to read  
3 as follows:

4 321.152 FEE FOR COUNTY. Each county treasurer shall be  
5 allowed to retain for deposit in the county general fund,  
6 ~~seventy-five-cents~~ five percent of the fee paid for each  
7 annual or semiannual vehicle registration and each duplicate  
8 registration card or plate issued; sixty-five percent of all  
9 fees collected for certificates of title, notations of lien  
10 or encumbrance and a certified copy of a certificate of ti-  
11 tle. The moneys retained shall be deducted, and reported  
12 to the department, when the county treasurer transfers the  
13 money collected under the provisions of this chapter; provided,  
14 however, that no such deduction shall be lawful unless the  
15 county treasurer has complied with the provisions of sections  
16 321.24 and 321.153.

17 EXPLANATION

18 The bill allows the county treasurer to retain five per-  
19 cent of the fee for each annual and semiannual vehicle regis-  
20 tration and each duplicate registration card or plate issued.
