1 An Act relating to driver education training.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one
2 hundred seventy-eight (321.178), subsection two (2), Code 1977,
3 is amended to read as follows:

4 2. YOUTHS NOT ATTENDING SCHOOL--NO DRIVER'S TRAINING
5 REQUIRED. Any person under the age of eighteen who is not
6 attending a public or private school in which an approved
7 driver's education course is offered or available, shall not be
8 required to complete an approved driver's education course
9 prior to being entitled to receive a one-year probationary
10 operator's license from the department. Any person who re-
11 enters any private or public school prior to age eighteen shall
12 be required to attend an approved driver's education course and
13 the department shall not suspend or revoke an operator's
14 license which has been issued to the person prior to the
15 person's re-entry into a public or private school, except for
16 violations of this chapter.

17 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that the state department of
20 transportation shall not suspend or revoke a probationary
21 operator's license issued to a drop-out who re-enters a public
22 or private school.
