3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:
4 "Section 1. Section eighty B point six (80B.6),
5 Code 1977, is amended by striking subsections two
6 (2), three (3), and nine (9)."
7 2. Page 2, by striking lines 6 through 9 and
8 inserting in lieu thereof the following:
9 "Sec. 4. This Act is effective January 1, 1978."

1 Section 1. Section eighty B point six (80B.6), Code 1977,
2 is amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following:

4 80B.6 COUNCIL CREATED--MEMBERSHIP.

5 1. There is created the Iowa law enforcement academy
6 council which shall consist of seven members appointed by
7 the governor with the consent of two-thirds of the members
8 of the senate. The members shall be appointed to four-year
9 terms commencing January 1, 1978, except that of the members
10 appointed to the council for terms of office commencing on
11 that date, three members shall be appointed to two-year terms.
12 All succeeding appointments shall be for four years. The
13 members of the council shall be electors of the state. When
14 considering persons for appointment to the council, the
15 governor shall consider persons with knowledge or educational
16 interests in law enforcement.

17 2. Vacancies occurring on the council shall be filled
18 by appointments for the unexpired term, subject to the consent
19 of two-thirds of the members of the senate.

20 Sec. 2. Section eighty B point eight (80B.8), Code 1977,
21 is amended to read as follows:

22 80B.8 COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. The members of the
23 council, who are not employees of the state or a political
24 subdivision, shall be paid a forty-dollar per diem. All
25 members of the council shall be reimbursed for necessary and
26 actual expenses incurred in attending meetings and in the
27 performance of their duties. All per diem and expense moneys
28 paid to ~~nonlegislative~~ members shall be paid from funds
29 appropriated to the Iowa law enforcement academy. ~~Legislative~~
30 ~~members-of-the-council-shall-receive-payment-pursuant-to~~
31 ~~section-2-40-and-section-2-42-~~

32 Sec. 3. Section eighty B point nine (80B.9), Code 1977,
33 is amended to read as follows:

34 80B.9 MEETINGS. The council shall meet at least four
35 times each year and shall hold special meetings when called

1 by the chairman or, in the absence of the chairman, by the
2 vice-chairman, or by the chairman upon written request of
3 ~~six~~ four members of the council. The council shall establish
4 procedures and requirements with respect to quorum, place,
5 and conduct of meetings.

6 Sec. 4. This Act is effective January 1, 1978. The
7 unexpired terms of office of persons serving on the Iowa law
8 enforcement academy council before January 1, 1978 shall
9 expire on December 31, 1977.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill reduces the membership of the Iowa law enforcement
12 academy council from twelve members to seven members. The
13 members are to be appointed to four-year, overlapping terms.
14 The governor when considering persons for appointment, is
15 to consider persons with knowledge or educational interest
16 in law enforcement.

17 The bill deletes reference to legislative and nonlegislative
18 members in regard to per diem and expense monies. The bill
19 further provides that a council meeting may be called at the
20 request of four members of the council instead of six.

1 Amend Senate File 159 as follows:

2 1. Page 1, by striking lines 5 through 19 and
3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "1. There is created the Iowa law enforcement academy
5 council which shall consist of seven members. Five
6 members shall be appointed by the governor with the
7 consent of two-thirds of the senate. One member shall
8 be appointed from the house of representatives by the
9 speaker of the house for a two year term. One member
10 shall be appointed from the senate by the lieutenant
11 governor for a four year term.

12 2. The gubernatorial appointees shall be
13 appointed to four year terms commencing January 1, 1978,
14 except that three of those initial appointments shall
15 be made for two years only. All succeeding gubernatorial
16 appointments shall be for four years. The appointee's
17 chosen pursuant to the provisions of this paragraph shall
18 be electors of the state. When considering persons for
19 appointment to the council, the governor shall consider
20 persons with knowledge or educational interests in law
21 enforcement.

22 3. The membership of the council shall consist
23 of no more than four persons belonging to the same
24 political party.

25 4. Vacancies occurring on the council shall be
26 made for the unexpired term according to the provisions of
27 this section."

28 2. Page 1, lines 29 through 31, by striking the
29 words "~~legislative-members-of-the-council-shall-receive~~
30 ~~payment-pursuant-to-section-2-10-and-section-2-12-~~" and
31 inserting in lieu thereof the words "Legislative members
32 of the council shall receive payment pursuant to section
33 2.10 and section 2.12".
