7 for the senior citizen employment program and \$100,000 for  
8 the development and maintenance of senior centers.

9 This bill also appropriates to the department of alco-  
10 holism and drug abuse, \$134,215 for salaries, support, main-  
11 tenance and miscellaneous purposes, \$900,000 for alcoholism  
12 treatment grants and \$362,258 for drug abuse programs. If  
13 the general assembly does not enact legislation creating the  
14 department, then the provisions of chapter 1105, Acts of the  
15 Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1976 Session would apply.  
16 Chapter 1105 requires the merger of the Iowa drug abuse au-  
17 thority and the division on alcoholism into a separate di-  
18 vision of the state department of health effective July 1,  
19 1977 and repeals chapters of the Code relating to the drug  
20 abuse authority and the division on alcoholism on that date.  
21 Funds appropriated by this Act to the department would then  
22 be allocated by the state comptroller to the merged division  
23 of the department of health.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the following agencies for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1977 and ending June 30, 1978, the following amounts or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the purposes designated:

  - a. For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes..... \$ 143,871
  - b. For the administration of area agencies on aging provided that existing area agencies on aging do not merge with one another..... \$ 96,000
  - c. For the senior citizen employment program..... \$ 100,000
  - d. For the development and maintenance of senior centers..... \$ 100,000
- 2. DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ABUSE
  - a. For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes..... \$ 134,215
  - b. For grants for alcoholism treatment..... \$ 900,000

c. For drug abuse programs..... \$ 162,758

Sec. 2. If legislation creating a department of alcoholism and drug abuse is not enacted by the Sixty-seventh General Assembly in 1977, funds appropriated in subsection two (2) of section one (1) of this Act shall be allocated by the state comptroller to the division of the state department of health created by the merger of the Iowa drug abuse authority and the division on alcoholism of the state department of health prescribed pursuant to section three (3) of chapter one thousand one hundred five (1005), Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1976 Session.
