A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing a livestock health advisory council
 2 to advise the Iowa state university of science and
 3 technology college of veterinary medicine on the
 4 application of funds appropriated and making an annual
 5 appropriation to the Iowa state university of science
 6 and technology college of veterinary medicine for
 7 research into livestock disease.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend Senate File 351 as follows:

2 1. Page 2, by striking lines 10 through 13, and
3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "2. Hold a meeting twice each year with the college
5 of veterinary medicine at Iowa state university. Hold
6 other meetings as the council may determine necessary,
7 or as required by section six (6) of this Act. No action
8 taken by the council shall be valid unless agreed to by
9 a majority of the council members."

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. DEFINITIONS. As used in this
2 Act,

3 1. "Livestock" means swine, sheep, poultry, and cattle.

4 2. "Producer" means a person engaged in the business of
5 producing livestock for profit.

6 3. "Iowa state university" means the Iowa state university
7 of science and technology.

8 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. LIVESTOCK HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL.

9 There is a livestock health advisory council, referred to
10 in this Act as the council. The council shall consist of:

11 1. Three cattle producers appointed by the Iowa cattlemens'
12 association, one of whom shall serve an initial term of one
13 year, and one of whom shall serve an initial term of two
14 years.

15 2. Three swine producers appointed by the Iowa pork
16 producers association, one of whom shall serve an initial
17 term of one year.

18 3. One sheep producer appointed by the Iowa sheep producers
19 association who shall serve an initial term of one year.

20 4. One poultry producer appointed by the Iowa poultry
21 association who shall serve an initial term of two years;

22 5. One milk producer appointed by the Iowa state dairy
23 association who shall serve an initial term of two years,
24 and

25 6. One practicing veterinarian appointed by the Iowa
26 veterinary medical association.

27 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. TERMS AND VACANCIES. Except as
28 provided in section two (2) of this Act, each member shall
29 be appointed for a three year term beginning on July first
30 of the year of appointment. No member shall serve more than
31 two terms, including any portion of a term served pursuant
32 to the filling of a vacancy. Vacancies shall be filled by
33 the appropriate organization in the same manner as appointing
34 full-term members.

35 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. SUPPLIES AND SERVICES. The

1 department of agriculture shall furnish the council with a
2 meeting place and all articles, supplies, and services
3 necessary to enable the council to perform its duties.

4 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. DUTIES AND OBJECTIVES OF COUNCIL.

5 The livestock health advisory council shall:

6 1. Elect a chairperson and such other officers as it deems
7 advisable. Officers of the council shall serve for terms
8 of one year. No member may serve in any one office for more
9 than two terms.

10 2. Hold a meeting at least once a year, or more often
11 as the council determines or is required by section six (6)
12 of this Act. No action taken by the council shall be valid
13 unless agreed to by a majority of council members.

14 3. Make recommendations to the Iowa state university
15 college of veterinary medicine concerning the application
16 of funds appropriated by this Act. The Iowa state university
17 college of veterinary medicine shall not expend any of the
18 funds appropriated by this Act until the recommendation of
19 the council concerning that appropriation is adopted or sixty
20 days following the effective date of the appropriation,
21 whichever is earlier.

22 Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. IOWA ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT.

23 The provisions of chapter seventeen A (17A) shall not apply
24 to the council or any actions taken by it, except that any
25 recommendations adopted by the council pursuant to subsection
26 three (3) of section five (5) of this Act and any rules adopted
27 by the council shall be adopted, amended, or repealed only
28 after compliance with the provisions of sections seventeen
29 A point four (17A.4), seventeen A point five (17A.5), and
30 seventeen A point six (17A.6) of the Code.

31 Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. OTHER FUNDS. In addition to the
32 funds appropriated to it by this Act, the Iowa state university
33 college of veterinary medicine may accept grants, gifts,
34 matching funds, or any other funds for research into the
35 diseases of livestock from any source, public or private.

9 fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred
10 thousand dollars. Any balance in said fund on June thirtieth
11 of each fiscal year shall revert to the general fund.

12 Sec. 9. Section two hundred sixty-six point twenty
13 (266.20), Code 1977, is repealed.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill creates a livestock health advisory council,
16 consisting of nine livestock producers, and one practicing
17 veterinarian, to make recommendations to the Iowa state
18 university college of veterinary medicine concerning the
19 university's application of funds appropriated by this bill.
20 While these recommendations are not binding upon the
21 university, the university may not expend the funds
22 appropriated by this bill until it receives the council's
23 recommendations, so long as those recommendations are timely
24 made. In addition, this bill makes an annual appropriation
25 of \$200,000 to the Iowa state university college of veterinary
26 medicine for research into the disease of livestock.

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A LIVESTOCK HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL
TO ADVISE THE IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND
TECHNOLOGY COLLEGE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE ON THE
APPLICATION OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED AND MAKING AN ANNUAL
APPROPRIATION TO THE IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE
AND TECHNOLOGY COLLEGE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE FOR
RESEARCH INTO LIVESTOCK DISEASE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. DEFINITIONS. As used in this Act,

1. "Livestock" means swine, sheep, poultry, and cattle.
2. "Producer" means a person engaged in the business of producing livestock for profit.
3. "Iowa state university" means the Iowa state university of science and technology.

Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. LIVESTOCK HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL. There is a livestock health advisory council, referred to in this Act as the council. The council shall consist of:

1. Three cattle producers appointed by the Iowa cattlemen's association, one of whom shall serve an initial term of one year, and one of whom shall serve an initial term of two years.
2. Three swine producers appointed by the Iowa pork producers association, one of whom shall serve an initial term of one year.
3. One sheep producer appointed by the Iowa sheep producers association who shall serve an initial term of one year.
4. One poultry producer appointed by the Iowa poultry association who shall serve an initial term of two years.
5. One milk producer appointed by the Iowa state dairy association who shall serve an initial term of two years; and
6. One practicing veterinarian appointed by the Iowa

veterinary medical association.

Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. TERMS AND VACANCIES. Except as provided in section two (2) of this Act, each member shall be appointed for a three-year term beginning on July first of the year of appointment. No member shall serve more than two terms, including any portion of a term served pursuant to the filling of a vacancy. Vacancies shall be filled by the appropriate organization in the same manner as appointing full-term members.

Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. SUPPLIES AND SERVICES. The department of agriculture shall furnish the council with a meeting place and all articles, supplies, and services necessary to enable the council to perform its duties.

Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. DUTIES AND OBJECTIVES OF COUNCIL. The livestock health advisory council shall:

1. Elect a chairperson and such other officers as it deems advisable. Officers of the council shall serve for terms of one year. No member may serve in any one office for more than two terms.
2. Hold a meeting twice each year with the Iowa state university college of veterinary medicine. Hold other meetings as the council may determine necessary, or as required by section six (6) of this Act. No action taken by the council shall be valid unless agreed to by a majority of the council members.
3. Make recommendations to the Iowa state university college of veterinary medicine concerning the application of funds appropriated by this Act. The Iowa state university college of veterinary medicine shall not expend any of the funds appropriated by this Act until the recommendation of the council concerning that appropriation is adopted or sixty days following the effective date of the appropriation, whichever is earlier.
4. File an annual report with the secretary of agriculture.

Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. IOWA ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT. The provisions of chapter seventeen A (17A) of the Code shall not apply to the council or any actions taken by it, except

that any recommendations adopted by the council pursuant to subsection three (3) of section five (5) of this Act and any rules adopted by the council shall be adopted, amended, or repealed only after compliance with the provisions of sections seventeen A point four (17A.4), seventeen A point five (17A.5), and seventeen A point six (17A.6) of the Code.

Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. OTHER FUNDS. In addition to the funds appropriated to it by this Act, the Iowa state university college of veterinary medicine may accept grants, gifts, matching funds, or any other funds for research into the diseases of livestock from any source, public or private.

Sec. 8. NEW SECTION. LIVESTOCK DISEASE RESEARCH FUND. There is created a fund in the office of the treasurer of state to be known as the livestock disease fund, and for the purpose of establishing and maintaining said fund for each fiscal year, there is appropriated from funds in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars. Any balance in said fund on June thirtieth of each fiscal year shall revert to the general fund.

Sec. 9. Section two hundred sixty-six point twenty (266.20), Code 1977, is repealed.
