A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the establishment of a depository library
2 center within the Iowa library department.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. DEFINITIONS. As used in this
2 Act unless the context otherwise requires:

3 1. "State agency" means a legislative, executive, or
4 judicial office of the state and all of its respective
5 officers, departments, divisions, bureaus, boards, commissions,
6 committees, and state institutions of higher education governed
7 by the state board of regents.

8 2. "State publications" means all multiply-produced
9 publications of state agencies regardless of format which
10 are supported by public funds, except correspondence and
11 memoranda intended solely for internal use within the agency
12 or between agencies, and materials designated by law as being
13 confidential.

14 3. "Depository library" means a library designated for
15 the deposit of state publications under the provisions of
16 this Act.

17 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. DEPOSITORY LIBRARY CENTER. There
18 is created within the Iowa library department a depository
19 library center. The state librarian shall appoint a depository
20 librarian who shall administer the depository library center.
21 The depository library center shall be the central agency
22 for the collection and distribution of state publications
23 to depository libraries.

24 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. DUTIES OF THE DEPOSITORY LIBRARIAN.
25 The depository librarian shall:

26 1. Enter into agreements according to rules promulgated
27 by the depository librarian pursuant to chapter seventeen
28 a (17A) of the Code with libraries for the deposit of state
29 publications in the libraries. Rules shall provide for the
30 classification of the libraries into depository libraries
31 which, for a specified period of time, maintain either a full
32 collection of state publications or a selected core of state
33 publications. The state library commission and the state
34 university of Iowa shall each permanently maintain two copies
35 of each state publication. One copy shall not be removed

1 from the library and the other copy may be loaned.

2 2. Adopt a classification scheme for state publications
3 and establish a record of the number and manner of
4 distribution.

5 3. Annually advise state agencies of the number of copies
6 of each class of publication needed for distribution.

7 4. Prepare, publish, and distribute on a quarterly basis
8 without charge to depository libraries, and upon the request
9 of other libraries or by subscription, a list of state
10 publications which list shall include a cumulated index.
11 The depository library center established in section two (2)
12 of this Act shall also prepare and publish decennial cumulative
13 indexes.

14 5. Provide to the library of Congress two copies of each
15 state publication collected.

16 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. Upon issuance of a state publication
17 a state agency shall deposit with the depository library
18 center at no cost to the center, seventy-five copies of the
19 publication, or a lesser amount if specified by the depository
20 librarian.

21 Sec. 5. Section eighteen point sixty-three (18.63),
22 unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1977, is amended to read
23 as follows:

24 The director may establish a central ~~library-and-depository~~
25 sales and distribution center from which shall be distributed
26 all books, pamphlets, documents, reports and publications
27 not required by law to be otherwise distributed. The director
28 shall from time to time establish the cost of printing and
29 distribution or mailing each book, pamphlet, report, document
30 and publication. The director shall, thereafter, cause to
31 be delivered, sent, or mailed to anyone requesting a book,
32 pamphlet, report, document, or publication upon receipt of
33 the cost thereof plus distribution or mailing charges.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill establishes a depository library center within
23 the Iowa library department for the collection and distribution
24 of state publications to libraries in this state. State
25 publications are defined as those which are paid for by public
26 funds. Current law provides only that the superintendent
27 of printing may maintain a library and depository and requires
28 distribution only to libraries designated by the federal
29 government as a depository for federal documents. The bill
30 also includes a number of clarifying amendments.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DEPOSITORY LIBRARY CENTER
WITHIN THE IOWA LIBRARY DEPARTMENT.
