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1 Section 1. Section one hundred ninety point one (190.1),  
2 subsection four (4), Code 1977, as amended by Acts of the  
3 Sixty-seventh General Assembly, 1977 Session, chapter eighty-  
4 three (83), section one (1), is amended to read as follows:

5 4. CHEESES AND CHEESE PRODUCTS. The specifications and  
6 standards for cheeses and cheese products, cottage cheese  
7 dry curd, cottage cheese, and low fat cottage cheese shall  
8 be as provided by the definitions and standards contained  
9 in federal food and drug standards under the ~~federal-Feed-~~  
10 ~~Drug--and-Cosmetic-Act~~ Code of Federal Regulations, Part ~~19~~  
11 thirty-three (33) of Title 21, as amended to April 1, ~~1976~~  
12 1977.

13 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ninety point one (190.1),  
14 subsection fifty-five (55), unnumbered paragraph two (2),  
15 Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

16 This definition is not intended to include such products  
17 as sterilized milk and milk products hermetically sealed in  
18 a container and so processed, either before or after sealing,  
19 as to prevent microbial spoilage, or evaporated milk, condensed  
20 milk, ice cream and other frozen desserts, butter, dry milk  
21 products, except as defined herein, cottage cheese dry curd,  
22 cottage cheese, low fat cottage cheese, cheese or cheese  
23 products except when they are combined with other substances  
24 to produce any pasteurized milk or milk product defined herein.

25 Sec. 3. Section one hundred ninety-two point thirty  
26 (192.30), Code 1977, is amended by adding the following new  
27 unnumbered paragraph.

28 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Municipal corporations may  
29 establish grade "A" standards for cottage cheese dry curd,  
30 cottage cheese, and low fat cottage cheese as a part of the  
31 ordinance required by this section; however no municipal  
32 corporation shall require a grade "A" rating for these products  
33 as a condition precedent to their sale within the city.

34 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect January 1, 1979.

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EXPLANATION

1 This bill clarifies existing statutory specifications and  
2 standards for cottage cheese dry curd, cottage cheese and  
3 low fat cottage cheese, and the right of municipal corpora-  
4 tions to adopt grade "A" standards for these products.

TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR THE PRODUCTION AND PROCESSING

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section one hundred ninety point one (190.1),  
subsection four (4), Code 1977, as amended by Acts of the  
Sixty-seventh General Assembly, 1977 Session, chapter eighty-  
three (83), section one (1), is amended to read as follows:

4. CHEESES AND CHEESE PRODUCTS. The specifications and  
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Drug, and Cosmetic Act Code of Federal Regulations, Part 49  
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ordinance required by this section; however no municipal  
corporation shall require a grade "A" rating for these products  
as a condition precedent to their sale within the city.

Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect January 1, 1979.
