A BILL FOR

1 An Act to prohibit the solicitation of funds and the sale of
2 food, beverages, or other goods in rest areas, on primary
3 highways and interstate highways and providing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code
2 1979, is amended by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. A person shall not solicit funds or offer
4 for sale any food, beverage, or tangible personal property
5 at a rest area located adjacent to any primary highway or
6 to a fully controlled-access, divided, multilaned highway
7 including the national system of interstate highways designated
8 by the federal highway administration and this state. A
9 person shall not solicit funds or offer for sale any food,
10 beverage, or tangible personal property on a primary highway
11 or a fully controlled-access, divided, multilaned highway
12 including the national system of interstate highways designated
13 by the federal highway administration and this state. This
14 section shall not be construed to prohibit the use of the
15 right-of-way of a primary highway or a fully controlled-access,
16 divided, multilaned highway including the national system
17 of interstate highways designated by the federal highway
18 administration and this state for charitable events when
19 approved by the department and under the direct supervision
20 of a peace officer and if such activities do not interfere
21 with travel by the public on the roadway.

22 Sec. 2. This Act is effective on January first following
23 its enactment.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The bill prohibits the solicitation of funds or the sale
26 of food, beverages, or other tangible personal property in
27 a rest area adjacent to a primary road or interstate highway
28 and on a primary road or interstate highway.
