A BILL FOR

1 An Act to require reports to employers for unemployment
2 compensation benefits paid former employees at the time
3 benefit checks are issued.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section ninety-six point seven (96.7),
2 subsection three (3), paragraph a, subparagraph six (6), Code
3 1979, is amended to read as follows:

4 ~~(6) As soon as practicable after the close of each calendar~~
5 ~~quarter, and in any event within forty days after the close~~
6 ~~of such quarter, At the time benefit checks are issued the~~
7 department shall notify each employer of the amount that has
8 been charged to the employer's account for benefits paid
9 ~~during such quarter. This statement~~ The notification to the
10 employer shall show the name of each claimant to whom ~~such~~
11 the benefit payments were made, the claimant's social security
12 number, and the amount of benefits paid to ~~such~~ the claimant
13 for the week covered in the statement. Any employer who has
14 not been notified as provided in section 96.6, subsection
15 2, of the allowance of benefits to such claimants may within
16 thirty days after the receipt of such statement appeal to
17 the director for a hearing to determine the eligibility of
18 the claimant to receive such benefits. The director shall
19 refer the same to a hearing officer for hearing and both the
20 employer and the claimant shall receive notice of the time
21 and place of ~~such~~ the hearing.

22 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January first following
23 its enactment.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill requires the department of job service to report
26 to the employer on a weekly basis the social security number
27 and name of a claimant receiving unemployment compensation
28 benefits and the amount paid to the claimant. Under present
29 law such notification is provided on a quarterly basis.

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
