A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide for the appointment of the board of trustees
2 of benefited fire districts.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section three hundred fifty-seven B point two
2 (357B.2), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

3 357B.2 BOARD OF TRUSTEES. A benefited fire district shall
4 be governed by a board of trustees consisting of three members
5 who shall serve overlapping, three-year terms. Each trustee
6 shall give bond in an amount to be determined by the board
7 of supervisors, the premium for which shall be paid by the
8 district of the trustee. The members of the board of trustees
9 shall be ~~elected-at-an-election-called~~ appointed by the board
10 of supervisors from among the qualified electors of the
11 district. ~~Notice-of-the-election-shall-be-given-by-publication~~
12 ~~in-two-succcessive-issues-of-a-newspaper-having-general~~
13 ~~circulation-within-the-district.--The-notice-shall-contain~~
14 ~~the-date,-time-and-locetion-of-the-election--The-final~~
15 ~~publication-of-the-notice-of-election-shall-not-be-less-than~~

29 to determine the amount of bond, or to dissolve the district
30 as provided in this chapter.

31 Sec. 2. UNEXPIRED TERM OF OFFICE--TRANSITION. This Act
32 shall not affect the term of office of a trustee of a benefited
33 fire district who is serving an unexpired term of office on
34 the effective date of this Act. Upon expiration of the term
35 of office, a successor shall be appointed to a three-year

1 term of office as provided in this Act. If a vacancy occurs,
2 a successor shall be appointed to the unexpired term of office
3 as provided in this Act.

4 Sec. 3. This Act is effective January first following
5 its enactment.

6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill provides for the appointment of the members of
8 the board of trustees of a benefited fire district. Under
9 current law, the trustees are elected to three-year terms,
10 but if a vacancy occurs it can be filled by an election or
11 by appointment of the board of supervisors.

In compliance with a written request received February 12, 19 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 226 pursuant to Joint Rule 16. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 226, An Act to require reports to employers for unemployment compensation benefits paid former employees at the time benefit checks are issued.

This bill requires the Department of Job Service to report to the employer on a weekly basis the social security number and name of a claimant receiving unemployment compensation benefits and the amount paid to the claimant. Under present law such notification is provided on a quarterly basis.
