1 Section 1. Section one hundred seven point eleven (107.11),  
2 Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

3 107.11 CONSERVATION DIRECTOR. ~~The commission shall employ~~  
4 ~~an administrative head who shall be known as state conservation~~  
5 ~~director and~~ state conservation director shall be appointed  
6 by the governor with the consent of two-thirds of the members  
7 of the senate. The director shall be the chief administrative  
8 officer of the department and shall be responsible to the  
9 ~~commission~~ for the execution of its the policies of the state  
10 conservation commission. ~~He~~ The director shall be a person  
11 of executive ability and possess special knowledge relative  
12 to the duties herein imposed on the commission and the  
13 department.

14 Sec. 2. Section one hundred seven point twelve (107.12),  
15 Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

16 107.12 TERM AND SALARY. ~~Said~~ The director shall serve  
17 during the pleasure of the ~~commission~~ governor and shall  
18 receive an annual salary as fixed by the general assembly.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill provides for the appointment of the state con-  
21 servation director by the governor with the consent of two-  
22 thirds of the members of the senate. The director shall serve  
23 at the pleasure of the governor.

24 This bill is effective July first following its enactment.
