1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, and
3 ending June 30, 1979, to the state board of regents, the sum
4 of five hundred fifty thousand (550,000) dollars, or so much
5 thereof as is necessary, to replace funds used by the
6 institutions under the control of the state board of regents,
7 to pay actual costs for the purchase of fuel and electricity
8 which exceeds fourteen million two hundred eighty-two thousand
9 (14,282,000) dollars. The funds or any portion of the funds
10 shall not be allocated unless the state comptroller determines
11 actual costs for the purchase of fuel and electricity exceeds
12 fourteen million two hundred eighty-two thousand (14,282,000)
13 dollars for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, and the
14 state comptroller approves allocation of the funds appropriated
15 by this Act.

16 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill appropriates funds to the state board of regents

AN ACT

MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF REGENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPLEMENTING EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS FOR FUEL AND PURCHASED ELECTRICITY DURING THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, and ending June 30, 1979, to the state board of regents, the sum of five hundred fifty thousand (550,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to replace funds used by the institutions under the control of the state board of regents, to pay actual costs for the purchase of fuel and electricity which exceeds fourteen million two hundred eighty-two thousand (14,282,000) dollars. The funds or any portion of the funds shall not be allocated unless the state comptroller determines actual costs for the purchase of fuel and electricity exceeds fourteen million two hundred eighty-two thousand (14,282,000) dollars for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, and the state comptroller approves allocation of the funds appropriated by this Act.
