1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Acts of the
2 Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Session, chapter fourteen
3 (14), section twelve (12), subsection two (2), paragraphs
4 b and c, there shall be allocated on the effective date of
5 this Act from funds appropriated pursuant to the Acts of the
6 Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Session, chapter fourteen
7 (14), section twelve (12), subsection two (2), paragraph b,
8 an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand (300,000)
9 dollars to be used by the Iowa beer and liquor control
10 department to purchase land described as lot 13, Ankeny
11 Industrial Park, which is located in Ankeny, Iowa, and for
12 closing costs related to the purchase of the land and for
13 any preliminary architectural fees incurred and payable between
14 the time of the effective date of this Act and July 1, 1980.
15 The attorney general and the executive council shall provide
16 assistance to the Iowa beer and liquor control department
17 if such assistance is needed in carrying out the provisions
18 of this Act.

19 This Act shall constitute the legislative directive to
20 the beer and liquor control department required by the Acts
21 of the Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Session, chapter
22 fourteen (14), section twelve (12), subsection two (2),
23 paragraph c.

24 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
25 takes effect from and after its publication in The Council
26 Bluffs Nonpareil, a newspaper published in Council Bluffs,
27 Iowa, and in The DeWitt Observer, a newspaper published in
28 DeWitt, Iowa.

29 EXPLANATION

30 This bill allocates from funds appropriated by the 1979
31 Session moneys to be used to purchase land, pay closing costs,
32 and pay preliminary architectural fees for the land selected
33 by the interim search committee created in the subsection
34 which appropriated the funds. The option to purchase the
35 land selected expires March 1, 1980. This Act is necessary

1 because the funds were appropriated effective July 1, 1980
2 and a legislative directive is also required by the Act
3 appropriating the funds.

AN ACT

ALLOCATING FUNDS FROM MONEYS APPROPRIATED TO THE IOWA BEER AND LIQUOR CONTROL DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SITE FOR A WAREHOUSE.

BE IT ENACIED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Acts of the Sixty-eighth General Asserby, 1979 Session, chapter fourteen (14), section twelve (12), subsection two (2), paragraphs b and c, there shall be allocated on the effective date of this Act from funds appropriated pursuant to the Acts of the Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Session, chapter fourteen (14), section twelve (12), subsection two (2), paragraph b, an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand (300,000) dollars to be used by the Iowa beer and liquor control department to purchase land described as lot 13, Ankeny Industrial Park, which is located in Ankeny, Iowa, and for closing costs related to the purchase of the land and for any preliminary architectural fees incurred and payable between the time of the effective date of this Act and July 1, 1980. The attorney general and the executive council shall provide assistance to the Iowa beer and liquor control department if such assistance is needed in carrying out the provisions of this Act.

This Act shall constitute the legislative directive to the beer and liquor control department required by the Acts of the Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Session, chapter fourteen (14), section twelve (12), subsection two (2), paragraph c.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect from and after its publication in The Council
