2 1979 Session, chapter eight (8), section twenty-eight (28),

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill changes the date of reversion of the funds in
16 the farm accounts of the Department of Social Services from
17 June 30, 1980 to June 30, 1981. The bill also allows the
18 farm account funds to be used for expenses incurred in farming
19 operations at the department's institution. The bill would
20 be effective upon publication.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE AND REVERSION OF THE UNENCUMBERED OR UN-OBLIGATED FUNDS REMAINING IN THE FARM ACCOUNTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-eighth General Assembly, 1979 Session, chapter eight (8), section twenty-eight (28), is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 28. Notwithstanding section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, the unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining in the farm accounts of the department of social services on June 30, 1979 shall not revert to the general fund until June 30, ~~1980~~ 1981. These funds may be used only for capital and operating expenses incurred in the farming operation.
