A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to unlawful picketing and making penalties
2 applicable.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Chapter 732, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION.

4 1. As used in this section, "labor dispute" includes a
5 controversy between an employer and two or more employees
6 concerning the terms or conditions of employment or concerning
7 the association or representation of a person in negotiation,
8 fixing, maintaining, charging, or seeking to arrange terms
9 or conditions of employment.

10 2. It is unlawful for a person, except an employee of
11 a particular employer establishment involved in a labor dis-
12 pute or a local resident member of the union representing
13 the employees of the establishment, to picket at the establish-
14 ment or elsewhere in the aid of the employees of the
15 establishment or in the furtherance of the labor dispute.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill prohibits persons not involved in a particular
18 labor dispute from picketing with or in aid of persons who
19 are involved in the dispute. The misdemeanor penalty in sec-
20 tion 732.4 would be applicable.

21 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
