13 EXPLANATION

14 In Senate File 2301 enacted last session which rewrote
15 the statutes governing senate confirmation of gubernatorial
16 appointments, a section was mistakenly repealed instead of
17 revised. This bill inserts in an existing section the language
18 which should have remained after the revision. The bill is
19 retroactive to January 1, 1981, the date Senate File 2301
20 became effective.

CORRECTING THE LAW RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF CERTAIN GUBERNATORIAL APPOINTMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 262.2, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

262.2 TERM OF OFFICE. The members shall be appointed by the governor subject to confirmation by the senate. The term of each member of the board shall be for six years. The terms of three members of the board shall begin and expire in each odd-numbered year as provided in section 69.19.
