7 the dollar amount which may be levied for the county
8 agricultural extension council budget."

1 Section 1. Section 176A.8, subsection 9, Code 1981, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 9. To prepare annually on or before January 31 a budget
4 for the fiscal year beginning July 1 and ending the following
5 June 30, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 24 and
6 certify the same to the board of supervisors of the county
7 of their extension district as required by law. The board
8 of supervisors shall review and approve the budget before
9 the levy is made under section 176A.11. If the board objects
10 to the budget, it shall be returned to extension council with
11 the objections noted.

12 Sec. 2. Section 176A.10, subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4, Code
13 1981, are amended to read as follows:

14 1. For an extension district having a population of less
15 than thirty thousand, an annual levy not to exceed twenty
16 and one-fourth cents per thousand dollars of the assessed
17 valuation of the taxable property in the district up to a
18 maximum of ~~fifty~~ seventy-five thousand dollars per annum.

19 2. For an extension district having a population of thirty
20 thousand or more but less than fifty thousand population,
21 an annual levy not to exceed twenty and one-fourth cents per
22 thousand dollars of the assessed valuation of the taxable
23 property in the district up to a maximum of ~~sixty~~ ninety
24 thousand dollars per annum.

25 3. For an extension district having a population of fifty
26 thousand or more but less than one hundred thousand population,
27 an annual levy not to exceed thirteen and one-half cents per
28 thousand dollars of the assessed valuation of the taxable
29 property in the district up to a maximum of ~~seventy-five~~ one
30 hundred twelve thousand five hundred dollars per annum.

31 4. For an extension district having a population of one
32 hundred thousand or more, an annual levy not to exceed thirteen
33 and one-half cents per thousand dollars of the assessed
34 valuation of the taxable property in the district up to a
35 maximum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars per annum.

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EXPLANATION

This bill provides that the board of supervisors approve the county agricultural extension council budget and increases the dollar amount which may be levied annually for the county agricultural extension education fund by fifty percent. This bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY SENATOR TAYLOR

In compliance with a written request there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 209 pursuant to Joint Rule 16.

S.F. 209 provides for the board of supervisors to approve the county agricultural extension council budget and increases by 50 percent the maximum dollar amounts which may be levied annually for the county agricultural extension education fund. The maximum allowable total levy and levy rate vary with county population, as shown in the following table:
