1 Section 1. Chapter 249A, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. Health care facilities licensed under chapter
4 135C receiving assistance payments for persons provided
5 services by the health care facility shall notify the
6 department in writing of a change in rates. Payment at a
7 new rate is effective for services rendered as of the first
8 day of the month in which the written notification of the
9 new rate is postmarked, or if the written notification is
10 personally delivered, in which the notification is received
11 by the department.

12 EXPLANATION

13 The department of social services currently provides by
14 rule that new rates for services provided by health care
15 facilities to medical assistance recipients are effective
16 the first day of the month in which written notice of the
17 rate change is received by the department. This bill makes
18 payment at the new rate effective for the first day of the
19 month in which the notice is postmarked or, only if hand
20 delivered, received by the department. The bill is effective
21 July 1 following enactment.
