1 Section 1. Section 332.6, Code 1981, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 332.6 COUNTY LAW LIBRARY.

4 1. The county board of supervisors may, ~~when in their~~
5 ~~discretion they shall deem it advisable,~~ provide by purchase
6 or otherwise for the procuring, and for the maintaining of
7 a suitable law library in the county courthouse, for the use
8 of the judges, county attorney, county officers and their
9 deputies, ~~besides~~ attorneys practicing in the courts of their
10 respective counties, and ~~such~~ other persons as ~~the supervisors~~
11 ~~may deem proper,~~ such authorized by the board. The library
12 shall be under the supervision and control of the judges of
13 the district court of the county ~~wherein the same~~ where it
14 is located.

15 2. Upon written request of the chief judge of its judicial
16 district or the clerk of the district court, the board of
17 supervisors, by resolution, may impose an additional fee,
18 not exceeding one dollar per filing in the office of clerk
19 of the district court, to be collected by the clerk of the
20 district court to purchase or maintain a county law library.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill provides that the board of supervisors, upon
23 the written request of the chief judge of the judicial district
24 or the clerk of the district court, may authorize the clerk
25 to collect an additional fee of not more than one dollar for
26 each filing made in the office of clerk of the district court
27 to purchase or maintain a county law library. This bill takes
28 effect July 1 following its enactment.
