1 Section 1. Section 257.28, Code 1981, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 257.28 NONRESIDENT PUPILS.

4 1. The boards of directors of two or more school districts
5 may by agreement provide for attendance of pupils residing
6 in one district in the schools of another district for the
7 purpose of taking courses not offered in the district of their
8 residence. Courses made available to students in this manner
9 shall be considered as complying with any standards or laws
10 requiring the offering of such courses. The boards of
11 directors of districts entering into such agreements may
12 provide for sharing the costs and expenses of such courses.

13 2. At the request of the parent or guardian of a pupil,
14 the board of directors of the district of residence of the
15 pupil shall enter into an agreement with the board of another
16 school district to provide for the attendance of the pupil
17 in the schools of the other school district and the payment
18 of costs. The agreement is subject to section 282.24.
19 Agreements entered into under this subsection are not eligible
20 for supplementary weighting under section 442.39.

21 Sec. 2. Section 442.39, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1981,
22 is amended to read as follows:

23 In order to provide additional funds for school districts
24 which send their resident pupils to another school district
25 for classes not offered in the district of residence, which
26 jointly employ and share the services of teachers under section
27 280.15, or which use the services of a teacher employed by
28 another school district for classes not offered in the district
29 of residence, a supplementary weighting plan for determining
30 enrollment is adopted. The supplementary weighting plan shall
31 not be used for attendance of pupils in the schools of another
32 district pursuant to section 257.28, subsection 2.

33 PARAGRAPH DIVIDED. The supplementary weighting plan is
34 as follows:

35 EXPLANATION

1 This bill requires a school district to make an agreement
2 with another district and pay the costs of sending a resident
3 pupil to a public school in another school district at the
4 request of the parent or guardian of the pupil. Supplementary
5 weighting would not apply to these pupils. The bill takes
6 effect July 1 following its enactment.
