1 Section 1. Section 41.1, subsection 50, Code 1981, as
2 amended by Acts of the Sixty-ninth General Assembly, Second
3 Extraordinary 1981 Session, chapter 1, section 2, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 50. The fiftieth representative district shall consist
6 of that portion of the city of Cedar Rapids bounded by a line
7 commencing at the point of intersection of Thirty-second
8 street northeast and "F" avenue northeast, then proceeding
9 north along "F" avenue northeast until it intersects Thirty-
10 fifth street northeast, then proceeding west along Thirty-
11 fifth street northeast until it intersects Oakland road
12 northeast, then proceeding northeasterly along Oakland road
13 northeast until it intersects Hollywood boulevard northeast,
14 then proceeding northwest along Hollywood boulevard northeast
15 until it intersects Richmond road northeast, then proceeding
16 southwesterly along Richmond road northeast until it intersects
17 Mark street northeast, then proceeding south along Mark street
18 northeast until it intersects Keith drive northeast, then
19 proceeding west along Keith drive northeast until it intersects

20 avenue southwest until it intersects Eighth street southwest,

9 b. In Cass county, Lincoln, ~~Messena~~ Massena, Victoria,
10 and Edna townships.

11 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
12 takes effect from and after its publication in The Decorah
13 Public Opinion, a newspaper published in Decorah, Iowa, and
14 in the Adams County Free-Press, a newspaper published in
15 Corning, Iowa.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill makes technical corrections to the descriptions
18 of legislative districts contained in the legislative
19 redistricting act, chapter 1, Acts of the Sixty-ninth General
20 Assembly, Second Extraordinary 1981 Session. The corrections
21 are effective for the 1982 general election and the bill takes
22 effect upon publication.
