1 Section 1. Section 279.34, Code 1981, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 279.34 FINANCIAL STATEMENT--PUBLICATION. In each school  
4 district, the board shall, during the ~~second-week~~ month of  
5 July of each year, publish by one insertion in at least one  
6 newspaper, if there is a newspaper published in said the  
7 district, a summarized statement verified by affidavit of  
8 the secretary of the board showing the receipts and  
9 disbursements of all funds for the preceding school year.  
10 ~~In all such districts of more than one hundred twenty-five~~  
11 ~~thousand population, the~~ The statement of disbursements ~~is~~  
12 ~~to show~~ shall list the names of the persons, ~~firms, or~~  
13 ~~corporations,~~ and the total amount paid to each during the  
14 school year. Information about receipts and disbursements  
15 is a public record under chapter 68A.

16 Sec. 2. Section 279.36, Code 1981, is repealed.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill strikes the section that requires school  
19 districts, except school districts of over 125,000 population,  
20 to publish quarterly a summary of the financial matters of  
21 the district for the previous quarter, including a list of  
22 all warrants. It requires all school districts, rather than  
23 just those of over 125,000 population, to publish annually  
24 during the month of July a statement of disbursements and  
25 states that information about receipts and disbursements is  
26 a public record. The bill takes effect July 1 following its  
27 enactment.
