18 EXPLANATION

19 The bill permits persons who pass the examination for city
20 or county assessor to be eligible for appointment as deputy
21 assessors without having to take both examinations. The bill

RELATING TO THE EXAMINATION AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY ASSESSORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 441.10, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

Immediately after the appointment of the assessor, and at other times as the conference board directs, one or more deputy assessors may be appointed by the assessor.

~~Appointments shall be made only from the list of eligible candidates provided by the director of revenue. The list of eligible candidates shall contain only the names of those persons who achieve a score of seventy percent or greater on the examination administered by the director of revenue~~

Each appointment shall be made from either the list of eligible candidates provided by the director of revenue, which shall contain only the names of those persons who achieve a score of seventy percent or greater on the examination administered by the director of revenue, or the list of candidates eligible for appointment as city or county assessor. Examinations for the position of deputy assessor shall be conducted in the same manner as examinations for the position of city or
