1 Section 1. Section 125.13, subsection 1, Code 1981, is
2 amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:
3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Four types of licenses may be
4 issued by the department. A standard renewable license may
5 be issued for two years. Licenses may also be issued for
6 one hundred eighty or two hundred seventy days, or one year.
7 A license issued for one hundred eighty or two hundred seventy
8 days shall not be renewed or extended. A one-year license
9 shall be issued no more than two consecutive times.

10 Sec. 2. Acts of the Sixty-ninth General Assembly, 1981
11 Session, chapter 58, section 12, subsection 3, unnumbered
12 paragraph 2, is amended by striking the unnumbered paragraph.

13 Sec. 3. Section 125.56, Code 1981, as amended by Acts

16 Sec. 4. It is the intent of the general assembly to renew
17 and strengthen substance abuse efforts in Iowa by continuing
18 the administration and coordination of services on a statewide
19 level. In recognition of the efficiency and economy that
20 can be gained by coordinating similar programs, it is further
21 the intent of the general assembly that all possible efforts
22 be made by the commission on substance abuse and the mental
23 health and mental retardation commission to coordinate the
24 administration of substance abuse and mental health services
25 in order to maximize the use of common resources and minimize
26 unnecessary duplication.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill extends the operation of the department of
29 substance abuse. The bill also provides for four types of
30 licenses, a two-year standard license, and licenses for one
31 hundred eighty, two hundred seventy days, or one year. The
32 bill also strikes the exemption of a facility or program which
33 does not receive state dollars from inspection by the
34 department of substance abuse. The bill encourages a
35 coordination of efforts between the commission on substance

1 abuse and the mental health and mental retardation commission
2 in the deliverance of substance abuse and mental health
3 services. The bill is effective July 1 following its
4 enactment.

REPORT OF THE FIRST CONFERENCE COMMITTEE
ON SENATE FILE 2245

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

We, the undersigned members of the conference committee appointed to resolve the differences between the Senate and the House of Representatives on Senate File 2245, a bill for an Act extending the operation of the department of substance abuse, striking the exemption of a program receiving state dollars from inspections by the department, and providing for four types of licenses, respectfully make the following report:

1. That the Senate recede from its amendment S-5639 to the House amendment S-5503 to Senate File 2245, as passed by the Senate.

2. That the House recede from its amendment S-5503 to Senate File 2245, as passed by the Senate.

3. That Senate File 2245, as passed by the Senate, be amended as follows:

1. Page 1, by inserting after line 9 the following:

"Sec. 2. Section 125.13, subsection 2, Code 1981, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-ninth General Assembly, 1981 Session, chapter 58, sections 4 through 7, is amended by adding the following new lettered paragraphs:

NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. Intervention and referral programs which are financed and managed by a county or counties, are staffed by county employees, and do not receive state payments pursuant to a contract under section 125.44.

NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. Voluntary, nonprofit groups whose funding is provided solely from nontax sources."

AN ACT

EXTENDING THE OPERATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE, STRIKING THE EXEMPTION OF A PROGRAM NOT RECEIVING STATE DOLLARS FROM INSPECTIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT, EXEMPTING CERTAIN COUNTY-FINANCED PROGRAMS WHICH DO NOT RECEIVE STATE FUNDS FROM LICENSING, AND PROVIDING FOR FOUR TYPES OF LICENSES.

Sec. 5. It is the intent of the general assembly to renew and strengthen substance abuse efforts in Iowa by improving supervision and coordination of services on a statewide level. In recognition of the efficiency and economy that can be gained by coordinating similar programs, it is further the intent of the general assembly that all possible efforts be made by the commission on substance abuse and the mental health and mental retardation commission to coordinate the administration of substance abuse and mental health services in order to make maximum use of common resources and to eliminate unnecessary duplication.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 125.13, subsection 1, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Four types of licenses may be issued by the department. A standard renewable license may be issued for two years. Licenses may also be issued for one hundred eighty or two hundred seventy days, or one year. A license issued for one hundred eighty or two hundred seventy days shall not be renewed or extended. A one-year license shall be issued no more than two consecutive times.
