1 Section 1. Chapter 7, Code 1981, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. TERRACE HILL AUTHORITY.

4 1. There is established the Terrace Hill authority
5 consisting of a governor's designee and eight persons appointed
6 by the governor who are knowledgeable in business management,
7 historic preservation and renovation. The terms of the
8 appointed members shall be for three years beginning on July
9 1 and ending on June 30.

10 2. The Terrace Hill authority is established to implement
11 the intent of the original gift of Terrace Hill and the federal

22 Sec. 2. Members of the Terrace Hill authority appointed
23 under the terms of the governor's executive order 26 shall

25 Upon the expiration of those terms, appointments shall be
26 made under this Act.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This Act codifies the Terrace Hill authority now existing
29 under the authority of the governor's executive order 26.
30 The authority is comprised of eight gubernatorial appointees
31 serving three-year terms and one designee of the governor.
32 The authority is authorized to implement state and federal
33 laws regarding historic preservation and public buildings,
34 to complete the preservation, renovation and landscaping of
35 Terrace Hill and to raise funds for these purposes.

36 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

Upon the expiration of those terms, appointments shall be made under this Act.

AN ACT
TO ESTABLISH THE TERRACE HILL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter 7, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. TERRACE HILL AUTHORITY.

1. There is established the Terrace Hill authority consisting of a governor's designee and eight persons appointed by the governor who are knowledgeable in business management, historic preservation and renovation. The terms of the appointed members shall be for three years beginning on July 1 and ending on June 30.

2. The Terrace Hill authority is established to implement the intent of the original gift of Terrace Hill and the federal and state laws regarding historic preservation and public buildings, to complete the preservation, renovation and landscaping of Terrace Hill, and to raise the necessary funds for these purposes.

3. The Terrace Hill authority may enter into contracts, subject to chapter 18, to execute its purposes.

4. The Terrace Hill authority may consult with the Terrace Hill Society, Terrace Hill Foundation, the executive and legislative branches of this state and other persons interested in the property.

Sec. 2. Members of the Terrace Hill authority appointed under the terms of the governor's executive order 26 shall continue to serve the terms provided for under that order.
