1 Section 1. Section 277.27, Code 1983, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 277.27 QUALIFICATION. A school officer or member of the
4 board shall, at the time of election or appointment, be an
5 eligible elector of the corporation or subdistrict.

6 ~~Notwithstanding any contrary provision of the Code, no member
7 of the board of directors of any school district, or his or
8 her spouse, shall receive compensation directly from the
9 school board. -- No director or spouse affected by this provision
10 on July 1, 1972, whose term of office for which elected has
11 not expired, or whose contract of employment has a fixed date
12 of expiration and has not expired, shall be affected by this
13 provision until the expiration of the term of office to which
14 elected, or the expiration date of the contract for which
15 employed.~~

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill removes the prohibition that members of the
18 boards of directors of school districts and their spouses
19 cannot receive compensation directly from the school board.
20 The bill would take effect July 1 following its enactment.
