### A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to decals or stickers on licenses indicating  
2 anatomical donations or the presence of medical conditions.

1 Section 1. Section 321.189, subsection 1, unnumbered para-  
2 graph 1, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

3 Upon the payment of the required fee, the department shall  
4 issue to every qualifying applicant an operator's license,  
5 motorized bicycle license or chauffeur's license, as applied  
6 for. Appearing on this license shall be a distinguishing  
7 number assigned to the licensee; the licensee's full name,  
8 date of birth, sex, and residence address; a colored  
9 photograph; a brief description of the licensee; and the usual  
10 signature of the licensee. If prior to the renewal date,  
11 a person desires to obtain an operator's or chauffeur's license  
12 in the form authorized by this section, ~~such~~ the license may  
13 be issued as a voluntary replacement upon payment of the  
14 required fee. The number of places where licenses are  
15 available shall not be reduced because of procedures or  
16 equipment required in placing colored photographs on licenses  
17 or permits. ~~The department shall provide a space on every~~  
18 ~~license where the licensee may affix a decal or sticker~~  
19 ~~indicating that the licensee is a donor under the Uniform~~  
20 ~~Anatomical Gift Act and shall provide a space where the~~  
21 ~~licensee may affix a symbol indicating the presence of a~~  
22 ~~medical condition.~~ The license may contain ~~such~~ other  
23 information as the department may by rule require. ~~No~~ A  
24 ~~license shall be~~ is not valid unless it bears the usual  
25 signature of the licensee. The department shall advise an  
26 applicant that ~~he or she~~ the applicant may request a number  
27 other than a social security number as the motor vehicle  
28 license number. The department shall not retain a positive  
29 or negative photograph of the licensee.

30 PARAGRAPH DIVIDED. The department shall advise the  
31 applicant that the applicant may have a decal or sticker  
32 attached to the license indicating that the licensee is a  
33 donor under the uniform anatomical gift Act or that the  
34 licensee is subject to a medical condition. The department  
35 shall correspondingly provide a space on every license where

1 the licensee may affix a decal or sticker indicating that  
2 the licensee is a donor under the uniform anatomical gift  
3 Act and shall provide a space where the licensee may affix  
4 a symbol indicating the presence of a medical condition.

5 The licensee may affix a decal or sticker on the license in  
6 the space provided which indicates that the licensee is a  
7 donor under the ~~Uniform-Anatomical-Gift~~ uniform anatomical  
8 gift Act. The decal shall not be larger than one-half inch  
9 in diameter. The use of the decal or sticker on the license  
10 ~~shall-be~~ is authorized only if the licensee has complied with  
11 the provisions for making a gift under the ~~Uniform-Anatomical~~  
12 ~~Gift~~ uniform anatomical gift Act and ~~shall-be~~ is effective  
13 only if the licensee carries on or about the licensee's person  
14 a duly signed and executed donor card as authorized by ~~the~~  
15 ~~Uniform-Anatomical-Gift~~ that Act.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill rearranges a paragraph describing the contents  
18 of a license so that all of the provisions relating to  
19 anatomical gifts are together. The bill also requires that  
20 the department advise applicants for licenses that the  
21 applicants may place decals or stickers on the license  
22 indicating an anatomical donation or the presence of a medical  
23 condition on the license.

24 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
