1 Section 1. Section 356.30, Code 1983, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 356.30 PRISONER TO PAY FOR BOARD COSTS. Every If re-  
4 quired by the board of supervisors, every prisoner gainfully  
5 employed is liable for the cost of his-board the prisoner's  
6 incarceration in the jail including but not limited to meals,  
7 medical expenses, security, and other costs as fixed by the  
8 county board of supervisors. The If the prisoner is on work  
9 release, the sheriff shall charge his the prisoner's account  
10 for such-board-and-any-meals the costs as provided in section  
11 356.31. If-the-prisoner-is-gainfully-self-employed-he-shall  
12 pay-the-sheriff-for-such-board,-in-default-of-which-his  
13 privilege-under-this-chapter-is-automatically-forfeited-  
14 If necessarily absent from jail at a meal time,-he and the  
15 prisoner so requests, the prisoner shall at-his-request be  
16 furnished with a lunch to carry to work. If the jail food  
17 is furnished directly, by the county, the sheriff shall account  
18 for and pay over such the meal payments to the county  
19 treasurer. The-county-board-of-supervisors-may-by-resolution  
20 provide-that-the-county-furnish-or-pay-for-the-transportation  
21 of-prisoners-employed-under-sections-356-26-to-356-35-to-and  
22 from-the-place-of-employment- If the board of supervisors  
23 requires prisoners to pay for the cost of their incarceration,  
24 the board shall adopt rules providing uniform procedures for  
25 discharged prisoners to make installment payments if they  
26 are unable to pay immediately upon release.

27 Sec. 2. Section 356.31, Code 1983, is amended to read  
28 as follows:

29 356.31 APPLICATION OF WAGES. By order of the court, the  
30 wages, salaries, or other income of employed prisoners on  
31 work release shall be disbursed by the sheriff for the  
32 following purposes and in the order stated.

33 1. Restitution ordered by the court pursuant to chapter  
34 910.

35 2. The meals costs of the prisoner.
