A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the registration fees for class "A" motor
2 homes.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

SENATE FILE 450 FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY SENATOR WELSH

In compliance with a written request there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 450 pursuant to Joint Rule 17.

Senate File 450 revises the registration fee schedule for class 'A' motor homes by adding an additional classification based on value and increases the valuation for the higher registration fees. The bill takes effect December first following enactment for registration fees payable on or after the date for vehicle registrations for the succeeding registration file.

Assumptions: 1) The number of class 'A' motor homes will remain the same if the new fee schedule is implemented. 2) The proportion of motor homes in each classification will remain constant.

Fiscal Impact: This represents a loss to RUTF of \$33,265, which would be passed on to the owners of the vehicles.

1 Section 1. Section 321.124, subsection 3, Code 1983, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. The annual registration fee for motor homes and
4 multipurpose vehicles is as follows:

5 a. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of ~~thirty-~~
6 ~~five~~ eighty thousand dollars or more as certified to the
7 department by the manufacturer, four hundred dollars for the
8 first five registrations and three hundred dollars for each
9 succeeding registration.

10 b. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of ~~twenty~~
11 forty thousand dollars or more but less than ~~thirty-five~~
12 eighty thousand dollars as certified to the department by
13 the manufacturer, ~~one~~ two hundred ~~forty~~ dollars for the first
14 five registrations and one hundred ~~five~~ fifty dollars for
15 each succeeding registration.

16 c. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of twenty
17 thousand dollars or more but less than forty thousand dollars
18 as certified to the department by the manufacturer, one hundred
19 forty dollars for the first five registrations and one hundred
20 five dollars for each succeeding registration.

21 e d. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of less
22 than twenty thousand dollars as certified to the department
23 by the manufacturer, one hundred twenty dollars for the first
24 five registrations and eighty-five dollars for each succeeding
25 registration.

26 d e. For a class "A" motor home which is a passenger-
27 carrying bus which has been registered at least five times
28 as a motor truck and which has been converted, modified or
29 altered to provide temporary living quarters, ninety dollars
30 for the first ten registrations and sixty-five dollars for
31 each succeeding registration. In computing the number of
32 registrations, the registrations shall be cumulative beginning
33 with the registration of the class "A" motor home as a motor
34 truck prior to its conversion, modification, or alteration
35 to provide temporary living quarters.

1 e f. For class "B" motor homes, ninety dollars for the
2 first five registrations and sixty-five dollars for each
3 succeeding registration.

4 f g. For class "C" motor homes, one hundred ten dollars
5 for the first five registrations and eighty dollars for each
6 succeeding registration.

7 g h. For multipurpose vehicles, seventy-five dollars for
8 the first five registrations and fifty-five dollars for each
9 succeeding registration.

10 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect December 1 following enact-
11 ment for registration fees payable on or after that date for
12 vehicle registrations for the succeeding registration year.

13 EXPLANATION

14 The bill revises the registration fee schedule for class
15 "A" motor homes by adding an additional classification based
16 upon value and increases the valuation for the higher regis-
17 tration fees. The bill takes effect December 1 following
18 enactment for registration fees payable on or after that date
19 for vehicle registrations for the succeeding registration
20 year.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION FEES FOR CLASS "A" MOTOR HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.124, subsection 3, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

3. The annual registration fee for motor homes and multipurpose vehicles is as follows:

a. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of ~~thirty-five~~ five eighty thousand dollars or more as certified to the department by the manufacturer, four hundred dollars for the first five registrations and three hundred dollars for each succeeding registration.

b. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of twenty forty thousand dollars or more but less than ~~thirty-five~~ eighty thousand dollars as certified to the department by the manufacturer, ~~one~~ two hundred ~~forty~~ fifty dollars for the first five registrations and one hundred ~~five~~ fifty dollars for each succeeding registration.

c. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of twenty thousand dollars or more but less than forty thousand dollars as certified to the department by the manufacturer, one hundred forty dollars for the first five registrations and one hundred five dollars for each succeeding registration.

e d. For class "A" motor homes with a list price of less than twenty thousand dollars as certified to the department by the manufacturer, one hundred twenty dollars for the first five registrations and eighty-five dollars for each succeeding registration.

d e. For a class "A" motor home which is a passenger-carrying bus which has been registered at least five times as a motor truck and which has been converted, modified or altered to provide temporary living quarters, ninety dollars for the first ten registrations and sixty-five dollars for each succeeding registration. In computing the number of registrations, the registrations shall be cumulative beginning with the registration of the class "A" motor home as a motor truck prior to its conversion, modification, or alteration to provide temporary living quarters.

e f. For class "B" motor homes, ninety dollars for the first five registrations and sixty-five dollars for each succeeding registration.

f g. For class "C" motor homes, one hundred ten dollars for the first five registrations and eighty dollars for each succeeding registration.

g h. For multipurpose vehicles, seventy-five dollars for the first five registrations and fifty-five dollars for each succeeding registration.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect December 1 following enactment for registration fees payable on or after that date for vehicle registrations for the succeeding registration year.
