1 Section 1. Chapter 110, Code 1983, is amended by adding
2 the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. RECIPROCITY IN HUNTING AND FISHING.

4 1. A nonresident may hunt and fish in this state without
5 an Iowa license if the nonresident has in immediate posses-
6 sion a valid hunting or fishing license issued to the non-
7 resident by that person's state of residence and if that state
8 allows hunting and fishing by Iowa residents who have Iowa
9 licenses. A nonresident who may hunt or fish under this
10 subsection is subject to all laws relating to the taking of
11 wildlife resources.

12 2. The commission may agree with any other state to li-
13 cense sport hunting and fishing by residents of the other
14 state at the same fee as Iowa residents are licensed if the
15 other state licenses Iowa residents at the same fee as
16 residents of the other state are licensed.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides that Iowa will allow a nonresident to
19 hunt or fish with a license from the nonresident's state if
20 that state will allow an Iowan to do so in that state with
21 an Iowa license. The bill allows the conservation commission
22 to agree with another state that the residents of both states
23 will be licensed to hunt or fish in the other state at the
24 fee charged to residents.

25 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.
