1 Section 1. Section 114.14, subsection 1, paragraph a,
2 Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. (1) Graduation from a course in engineering of four
4 years or more in a school or college which, in the opinion
5 of the board, will properly prepare the applicant for the
6 examination in fundamental engineering subjects. ~~in~~

7 (2) However, prior to July 1, 1985, in lieu of graduation
8 from-a-school-or-college compliance with subparagraph (1),
9 the board may accept eight years' practical experience which,
10 in the opinion of the board, is of satisfactory character
11 to properly prepare the applicant for the examination in
12 fundamental engineering subjects.

13 (3) Between July 1, 1985 and June 30, 1988, in lieu of
14 compliance with subparagraph (1), the board shall require
15 satisfactory completion of a minimum of two years of post
16 high school study in mathematics, physical sciences,
17 engineering technology, or engineering at an institution
18 approved by the board, and may accept six years' practical
19 experience which, in the opinion of the board, is of
20 satisfactory character to properly prepare the applicant for
21 the examination in fundamental engineering subjects.

22 Sec. 2. Section 114.14, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
23 1983, is amended to read as follows:

24 a. (1) Graduation from a course ~~in-engineering~~ of four
25 years or more in mathematics, physical sciences, mapping and
26 surveying, or engineering in a school or college which, in
27 the opinion of the board, will properly prepare the applicant
28 for the examination in fundamental land surveying subjects.

32 the board may accept eight years' practical experience which,
