 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.J.R. 6

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
2 of the State of Iowa is proposed:

3 Article III, Legislative Department, Constitution of the
4 State of Iowa, is amended by adding the following new section:

5 NEW SECTION. The general assembly may nullify an adopted
6 administrative rule of a state agency by the passage of a
7 resolution by a majority of all of the members of each house
8 of the general assembly.

9 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been
10 adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-ninth General Assembly,
11 1982 Session, thereafter duly published, and now adopted and
12 agreed to by the Seventieth General Assembly in this joint
13 resolution, shall be submitted to the people of the state
14 of Iowa at the general election in November of the year
15 nineteen hundred eighty-four in the manner required by the
16 Constitution of the State of Iowa and the laws of the state
17 of Iowa.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This constitutional amendment allows the general assembly
20 to nullify an adopted administrative rule by the passage of
21 a concurrent resolution adopted by a constitutional majority
22 in the senate and the house of representatives.

A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IOWA TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATURE TO VOID A RULE OF A STATE AGENCY BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is proposed:

Article III, Legislative Department, Constitution of the State of Iowa, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. The general assembly may nullify an adopted administrative rule of a state agency by the passage of a resolution by a majority of all of the members of each house of the general assembly.

Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-ninth General Assembly, 1982 Session, thereafter duly published, and now adopted and agreed to by the Seventieth General Assembly in this joint resolution, shall be submitted to the people of the state of Iowa at the general election in November of the year
