1 Section 1. Section 321.285, Code 1985, is amended by
2 adding the following new unnumbered paragraphs:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Any person driving a motor
4 vehicle in violation of the posted speed limit by fifteen
5 miles per hour or less on a primary road as defined by section
6 306.3, subsection 2, in a car which averages more than twenty
7 miles per gallon for the speed at which the vehicle is cited,
8 shall be charged with an unnecessary waste of a resource
9 controlled by foreigners rather than being charged with
10 violating the speed limit, unless the driver of the vehicle is
11 involved in an accident, or is intoxicated or drugged in
12 violation of section 321.281.

13 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The penalties for violating the
14 speed limit and for an unnecessary waste of a resource
15 controlled by foreigners are the same, except as provided by
16 sections 22.7, subsection 19, 321.207, and 321.210.

17 Sec. 2. Section 22.7, Code 1985, is amended by adding the
18 following new subsection:

19 NEW SUBSECTION. 19. Reports, informations, citations, or
20 warnings issued for, or court reports of convictions of an
21 unnecessary waste of a resource controlled by foreigners as
22 defined by section 1 of this Act.

23 Sec. 3. Section 321.207, Code 1985, is amended to read as
24 follows:

25 321.207 RECORD FORWARDED.

26 Every court having jurisdiction over offenses committed
27 under this chapter, or any other law of this state or any city
28 or county traffic ordinances, other than parking regulations,
29 regulating the operation of motor vehicles on highways, shall
30 forward to the department a record of the conviction of any
31 person in the court for a violation of any of the laws, except
32 records classified confidential under section 22.7, subsection
33 19, and may recommend the suspension of the operator's or
34 chauffeur's license of the person convicted, and the
35 department shall consider and act upon the recommendation.
