1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 266.40 SHORT TITLE.

2 This division shall be known and may be cited as the "Iowa
3 fire service institute Act".

4 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 266.41 STAFF FIRE ACADEMY --
5 PURPOSE.

6 Iowa state university of science and technology shall
7 operate a state fire academy called the Iowa fire service
8 institute, for instructing the general public and fire
9 protection personnel throughout the state, providing service
10 to public and private fire departments in the state, and
11 conducting research in the methods of maintaining and
12 improving fire prevention, fire protection, and control
13 services consistent with the needs of Iowa communities.

14 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 266.42 ENROLLMENT.

15 Enrollment and attendance in the fire service institute
16 programs may include, but is not limited to, persons engaged
17 in fire administration, fire prevention, fire suppression,
18 fire education, or fire and arson investigation with a unit of
19 government or a public or private fire department in the
20 state, including volunteer, trainee, or employed fire
21 fighters.

22 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 266.43 PROGRAMS.

23 Programs conducted by the institute shall include at least
24 instruction in the subjects necessary for the certification of
25 its students in accordance with the standards of the voluntary
26 national professional qualification system established by the
27 joint council of national fire service organizations and
28 adopted by the fire service institute. The institute may
29 develop and conduct programs which extend beyond the programs
30 directly related to the standards.

31 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. 266.44 DUTIES.

32 The fire service institute shall:

33 1. Assist public and private fire departments in Iowa
34 through education, training, counseling, measurement, and
35 evaluation services.

1 2. Conduct statewide, regional, and local educational and
2 training programs in Iowa which will provide opportunities to
3 comply with the certification requirements of the professional
4 qualifications standards pursuant to section 266.43 to fire
5 fighters, fire department officers, and other persons.

6 3. Offer programs of education and instruction, conducted
7 by a staff of full-time and part-time faculty.

8 4. Plan and conduct an annual state fire school and other
9 short courses of instruction.

10 5. Provide applied research to support fire training and
11 education programs.

12 6. Develop and distribute instructional and educational
13 materials to support the fire training and education programs
14 offered by the institute.

15 7. Develop mechanisms by which fire fighters and others
16 may earn college credits and degrees in fire-related disci-
17 plines.

18 8. Develop and offer other programs and services con-
19 sistent with the general purposes of the institute.

20 9. Cooperate with and assist all state agencies concerning
21 fire protection matters.

22 10. Plan, construct, operate, and control training fa-
23 cilities and structures as necessary to conduct the institute.

24 Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. 266.45 EXECUTIVE OFFICER.

25 The president of Iowa state university of science and
26 technology, with the approval of the state board of regents,
27 shall appoint the executive officer of the fire service
28 institute and other employees of the institute.

29 Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. 266.46 ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

30 The fire service institute advisory committee is estab-
31 lished to advise the institute. The advisory committee shall
32 be composed of appropriate fire service interest groups and
33 organizations. The advisory committee shall be appointed by
34 the president of Iowa state university of science and
35 technology. The president shall appoint the chairperson of

1 the advisory committee. The members of the advisory committee
2 shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to implement this
3 division.

4 The executive officer of the institute shall not serve on
5 the advisory committee but may designate a member of the
6 institute staff to serve as a secretary for the advisory
7 committee. The members of the advisory committee shall not
8 receive per diem, but may be reimbursed by the institute for
9 reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out their duties.

10 Sec. 8. NEW SECTION. 266.47 APPROPRIATIONS.

11 The facilities and structures utilized for fire service
12 education when the division is enacted shall be incorporated
13 into the fire service institute. The state board of regents
14 shall include the fire service institute in its budgetary
15 process.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill establishes a fire service institute within Iowa
18 state university of science and technology. Duties of the
19 institute are prescribed and an advisory committee is created
20 to advise the institute.

9. Cooperate with and assist all state agencies concerning fire protection matters.

10. Plan, construct, operate, and control training facilities and structures as necessary to conduct the institute.

Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. 266.45 EXECUTIVE OFFICER.

The president of Iowa state university of science and technology, or the president's designee, shall appoint the executive officer of the fire service institute and other employees of the institute.

Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. 266.46 ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

The fire service institute advisory committee is established to advise the institute. The advisory committee shall be composed of two members from each of the following organizations chosen from a list of names, submitted by each of the following organizations: Iowa firemen's association, Iowa fire chiefs' association, Iowa association of professional firefighters, Iowa association of professional fire chiefs, Iowa society of fire service instructors, hawkeye state fire safety association, and Iowa chapter of the international association of arson investigators. The advisory committee shall be appointed by the president of Iowa state university of science and technology. The president shall appoint the chairperson of the advisory committee.

The executive officer of the institute shall not serve on the advisory committee but may designate a member of the institute staff to serve as a secretary for the advisory committee. The members of the advisory committee shall not

receive per diem, but may be reimbursed by the institute for reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out their duties.
