AN ACT

RELATING TO RIGHTS OF A PERSON POSSESSING A TEACHING CERTIFICATE WITH A COACHING ENDORSEMENT AND NOT ISSUED A TEACHING CONTRACT WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 279.19B, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

The board of directors of a school district may employ for head coach of other interscholastic athletic activities or for assistant coach of any interscholastic athletic activity, an individual who possesses a coaching authorization issued by the department of public instruction. An individual who has been issued a coaching authorization or who possesses a teaching certificate with a coaching endorsement but is not issued a teaching contract under section 279.13 and who is employed by the board of directors of a school district serves at the pleasure of the board of directors and is not subject to sections 279.13 through 279.19, and 279.27. Chapter 272A
