RELATING TO THE MAKEUP OF THE BOARD OF NURSING EXAMINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 147.14, subsection 3, Code Supplement 1985, is amended to read as follows:

3. For nursing examiners, one ~~four~~ registered nurse representing the colleges and universities; one registered nurse representing the hospital-conducted schools of nursing; one registered nurse representing the area community and vocational-technical nursing department; one registered nurse practitioner; nurses, one of whom shall be actively engaged in practice, three of whom shall be nurse educators from nursing education programs; of these one in higher education, one in diploma education, and one in area community and vocational technical registered nurse education; one licensed practical nurse practitioner, actively engaged in practice, and two members not registered nurses or licensed practical nurses and who shall represent the general public. The representatives of the general public shall not be members of health care
