2 1. Page 1, line 15, by inserting after the word  
3 "violators." the words "However, when they are not on  
4 land or water under the jurisdiction of the commission  
5 the officers and supervisory personnel of the lands  
6 and waters division are only authorized to enforce the  
7 laws of this state which are under the jurisdiction of  
8 the commission and the trespass laws."

1 Section 1. Section 107.13, Code 1985, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 107.13 OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

4 The director shall, with the consent of the commission,  
5 employ the number of assistants, including a professionally  
6 trained state forester, that are necessary to carry out the  
7 duties imposed on the commission; and, under the same  
8 conditions, the director shall appoint the number of full-time  
9 officers and supervisory personnel that are necessary to  
10 enforce all the laws of the state and rules and regulations,  
11 ~~the-enforcement of which-are-imposed-on~~ the commission. The  
12 full-time officers and supervisory personnel shall have the  
13 same powers that are conferred by law on peace officers in the  
14 enforcement of all the laws of the state of Iowa and the  
15 apprehension of violators. Any A person appointed as a full-  
16 time officer shall be at least twenty-one years of age, but  
17 not more than sixty-five years of age, on the date of  
18 appointment. ~~Officer~~ "Full-time officer" means any person  
19 appointed by the state conservation commission to enforce the  
20 laws of this state ~~under-the-jurisdiction-of-the-commission~~.

21 Sec. 2. Section 107.14, Code 1985, is amended to read as

23 107.14 TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS OFFICERS.

24 The commission director may appoint temporary officers for  
25 a period not to exceed six months. ~~The-commission-may and~~  
26 adopt minimum physical, educational, mental, and moral

29 officers. Temporary officers have all the powers of peace

31 and the trespass laws.

33 EXPLANATION

34 This bill provides that the full-time officers of the state  
35 conservation commission enforce all the laws of the state and

1 not just those under the jurisdiction of the commission.  
2 Temporary officers would have limited powers. The authority  
3 to appoint supervisory personnel as special police is  
4 repealed.
